A \$3.00 AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE and a 50¢ RECORDING FEE will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club, Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These Fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only (AKC Rules Chapter 14, Section 2).

TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE, and UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS and PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS please make fees payable in U.S. funds.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute valid entry fees. A \$25 collection fee will be added to the amount of each check returned by the bank. Subsequent checks (or checks not made good) by the same exhibitor will result in transactions being conducted on a CASH ONLY BASIS with that exhibitor.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Overpayments may be picked up at the show only.

DOGS NOT REQUIRED FOR FURTHER JUDGING will be excused.

OWNERS AND HANDLERS will be responsible for the dogs at ringside when the classes are called to be judged. Judging cannot be held up to locate absentees.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise ring.

THIS SHOW MAY BE CANCELED according to AKC rules in event of extreme weather.
